At the age of 5, **Cody Deaner** had one goal... to one day wrestle in the same ring as his childhood hero – Hulk Hogan. Despite his smaller size, and a high school guidance counsellor who told him not to pursue a career in professional wrestling, Cody achieved his dream and eventually wrestled for the largest wrestling company in North America. He speaks to youth about the power of positivity and perseverance. His goal now is to focus on being a positive influence and tells stories of the power of positivity, being a small town hero to children all across Canada, and starting a charity campaign, *Giv'er for Charity*.

Dillon Mendes is an alumni of the Top 35 Under 35 Global Changemaker awards, social entrepreneur, TEDx & youth speaker as well as an analyst at Deloitte Canada. Dillon co-founded the social enterprise, [PickWaste](#) (featured on CBC, CTV and CityNews) which has, and continues to have, a massive impact on the environment.
